



**DOXYCYCLINE PRODUCTS PA SUMMARY**

<b>PREFERRED</b>	Doxycycline hyclate immediate release (generic), Doxycycline monohydrate capsules (50, 100, 150mg), Doxycycline monohydrate tablets (75, 100, 150mg), Vibramycin (oral suspension, syrup)
<b>NON-PREFERRED</b>	Doxycycline orals suspension (generic), Doxycycline monohydrate capsules (75mg), Doxycycline monohydrate tablets (50mg), Doryx (brand and generic) tablets, Morgidox Kit (doxycycline hyclate with cleanser)

**NOTE:** If generic doxycycline hyclate delayed-release is approved, the PA will be issued for brand-name Doryx.

**LENGTH OF AUTHORIZATION:** 1 Year

**PA CRITERIA:**

*For Doryx (brand and generic) and Morgidox Kit*

- ❖ Submit a written letter of medical necessity stating the reason(s) that generic Vibramycin (doxycycline hyclate immediate-release) is not appropriate for the member.

*For Doxycycline Monohydrate 75mg capsules*

- ❖ Submit a written letter of medical necessity stating the reason(s) that doxycycline monohydrate 75mg tablets are not appropriate for the member.

*For Doxycycline Monohydrate 50mg tablets*

- ❖ Submit a written letter of medical necessity stating the reason(s) that doxycycline monohydrate 50mg capsules are not appropriate for the member.

*For Doxycycline oral suspension (generic)*

- ❖ Submit a written letter of medical necessity stating the reason(s) that brand-name Vibramycin oral suspension is not appropriate for the member.

**EXCEPTIONS:**

- ❖ Exceptions to these conditions of coverage are considered through the prior authorization process.
- ❖ The Prior Authorization process may be initiated by calling **Catamaran at 1-866-525-5827.**
