



**PUBLIC NOTICE OF
OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC INPUT
NON-EMERGENCY MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM**

The Georgia Department of Community Health (DCH) is providing public notice of its intent to gather input from community stakeholders, including healthcare providers and Medicaid members regarding the Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) Program. The NEMT program provides medically necessary, cost-effective transportation to and from facilities for eligible Medicaid members with no other means of transportation available. DCH manages the NEMT program through contracts with transportation brokers, which are currently set to expire June 30, 2017. DCH, in partnership with the Georgia Department of Administrative Services, is currently preparing to conduct a procurement to establish new broker contracts for the NEMT programs. DCH is seeking input from community stakeholders and partners all across Georgia for ideas to consider in program improvement and innovation. Specifically, DCH is seeking input on the following:

- What program design changes or modifications to the NEMT program should DCH consider to drive healthier outcomes for the Medicaid population?
