


Information for the Designated Record Set is contained within the Documentum system. A request for information is initiated using the requestor's member id.

NOTICE OF MEDICAID STATUS

You continue to be eligible for Medicaid even though you no longer receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments through the Social Security Administration. We determined that you are eligible for Medicaid for a reason other than receiving SSI. Your Medicaid card continues as usual.

Your eligibility for Medicaid is now through your local county Department of Family and Children Services (DFCS). If you need to report an address change or other changes, you are to contact your local county DFCS office.
