



MEDICAID-PEACHCARE NOTIFICATION 04/30/2008: OUTPATIENT FEE-FOR-SERVICE PHARMACY PROGRAM IMPORTANT UPDATE

IMPORTANT PLAN CHANGES EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2008:

NPI (National Provider ID)

Pharmacy Provider NPI: Required effective May 1, 2008

NCPDP will no longer be accepted for GA Medicaid Fee-for Service electronic claims effective May 1, 2008. Please submit the ID qualifier '01' (NPI) in field 202-B2 and the pharmacy NPI (Service Provider ID) in field 201-B1.

Prescriber NPI: Required effective May 23, 2008

Claims may be submitted with the prescriber's NPI or State license number between May 1 – May 22. Dummy IDs will no longer be accepted effective May 1, except for GHS300 and AOH300 when appropriate. Beginning May 23, only Prescriber NPI will be accepted; GHS300 and AOH300 and prescriber state license numbers will no longer be accepted.

Submit the ID qualifier '01' for prescriber NPI in NCPDP field 466-EZ and the prescriber NPI in field 411-DB.

DATE PRESCRIPTION IS WRITTEN:

Effective May 1, 2008, claims submitted must include the date the prescription was written in NCPDP field 414-DE (DATE PRESCRIPTION IS WRITTEN).
